The Marine Corps began to grow smaller in 1988. The Navy did not start declining in number until 1990. Its delay in carrying out personnel cuts was due to the fact that it had been pursuing a major program to build up to a fleet of 600 ships. In the late 1980s, the service still did not have the sailors it needed to crew a fleet of that size. The rise of Gorbachev in the USSR signaled a change in the U.S. security environment. The fall of the Berlin Wall in 1989 was evidence of that transformation. The disintegration of the Soviet Union two years later was proof. This
