Pieter Bruegel Dec 07 2021 The life and times of Pieter Bruegel the Elder (c. 1526/30-1569) were marked by stark cultural conflict. To this end, he developed his own pictorial language of dissidence, lacing innocuous everyday scenes with subliminal statements in order to escape repercussions. To produce this XXL-sized collection, TASCHEN undertook a comprehensive photographic campaign, capturing all the breadth and splendid detail of Bruegel's oeuvre like never before.
